



## Tablet Rally – Explanation

We do Tablet-Rallies for groups up to about 1000 participants.

The whole group will be split into teams of 5 to 10 people. The actual group size is flexible and can be adjusted to your requirements. However, the ideal team size is about 7 participants per team.

After the group has been split into teams, we will explain the rules of the game to everyone. If the group is smaller than 50 people we can do the game instructions at the starting point. If your group should be bigger we will require a room including a projector, a screen and a sound system. The game instructions including the handing out of the tablets to each team will take 15 to 20 minutes.

After the game instruction, we will hand out the tablets to each team. All tablets have our phone number (Rally-Hotline) marked on the back. This phone number can be used during the whole duration of the game if there should be any problems or questions.

The first task of the game is to find a team name and to take a group photo. Only then will all the icons appear on the city map and the game will start.

If required we can create a starting challenge that will start immediately after the tablets have been handed out. Usually it consists of a company specific welcome message to the teams as well as a motivational video, which you will be required to provide.

We have a selection of different challenges – a set of tasks at each station – which are marked on the map with an icon, which indicates what kind of challenges the team will have to do there. The challenges can have a focus on music, history, cuisine, nature or can be riddles, chrono (task against the time), video-task, etc. Many challenges also include a photo task. During the game, each team can choose in which direction they want to go and which challenges they will do.

During the Rally we can track the team via GPS. We always know where they are and can communicate with them via “Live-message”.

Via “Live-scoring” we have an overview of how many points each team has. With the “Life-Feed” we oversee which answers the teams give. If a team should type an answer incorrectly for one of the open questions and the team loses that point, the administrator can decide to give that point back to the team if perhaps it was only a grammar mistake.



The game includes a variety of questions, which are designed to keep the game interesting and challenging. There are open questions to be answered as well as multiple choice questions. We have video and photo tasks and much more. In between the task we also include information slides that give more insight into what they can see at that point of interest.

If required and for an additional charge we can include interactive stations like waltz dancing, food or wine tastings, etc.

Also for additional charges we can include your logo as watermark on all slides of the game. It is also possible to include company specific questions in the game if you want to.

The Rally can be set for a specific amount of time (for example two hours) or it ends at a specific time (for example 5:30 pm).

15 minutes before the end time an alarm will be set off on each tablet. It reminds participants that they only have 15 minutes left to conclude their tasks.

At the end time, all icons on the map will disappear only the end station will be left. The end station can be a hotel, a restaurant or any other location you require.

The teams come to the end station and all tablets will be collected from the teams.

Our staff will then download all the data from each tablet. The end score of each team will be determined. All right answers and gathered points will be included as well as all the photos and videos that were taken during the Rally.

The teams can take photos and videos all through the course of the Rally even if the team is not doing a challenge. That means that the team can always go into the menu and shoot videos and photos if they feel like it.

We will provide all the photos and videos to you as a download link via Dropbox or WeTransfer after the rally.

After the ranking has been concluded there will be an award ceremony. We can do the moderation if required. If wanted we can also make certificates for each participant that will be handed out at the award ceremony.

If you have the possibility to project videos and photos at the end station, we can show the videos and pictures after the ceremony.
